

MEADOWBROOK WATER LINE UPGRADE

Sealed Bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for the construction of the Meadowbrook Water Line Upgrade will be received at the West Overton Utility District office, located at 684 Rickman Monterey Highway, until **2:00 p.m.**, local time, on **December 5, 2024**, and then at said location publicly opened and read aloud. Any person with disability requiring special accommodations must contact West Overton Utility District no later than 7 days prior to the bid opening

The Project consists of constructing a new 6-inch water line upgrade within the Meadowbrook Subdivision. The project consists of approximately 5,500 linear feet of 6-inch PVC water line; installation of air release valves; replacement of new service laterals; and installation of associated appurtenances.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

Call prior to picking up documents to ensure availability. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available directly from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of bidding Documents including Addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. No part of the purchase will be refunded.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, prepared on the form of Bid Bond attached to the Contract Documents or a Surety Company's Standard Bid Bond, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Tennessee and listed as a certified company in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, in the amount of five percent of the Bid.

No bid may be withdrawn within 60 calendar days after the scheduled time for receipt of bids. All bidders must be licensed and shall comply with all requirements of the State of Tennessee Contractor's Licensing Act. The Owner will in no way be liable for any costs incurred by any bidder in the preparation of its Bid in response to this Invitation to Bid.

The successful Bidder for this Contract will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of 100 percent of the Bid. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive informalities and to readvertise.
